

Clothing labelling is regulated in Canada and in United States. Take into consideration the information below when having your labels created.

## CLOTHING LABELLING REQUIREMENTS :

### 1 - FIBER CONTENT

Use the Generic Terms for Natural Fibers or for Man Made Fibers. Fibers must be listed in order showing the highest percentage first.  
Must appear in English and French. (Canadian requirement)

### 2 - COUNTRY OF ORIGIN

Country where your product was made.  
Label at the center back neck of the garment. (United States requirement)

### 3 - DEALER IDENTITY (CA NUMBER)

Name and full postal address of company or CA Number.

### 4 - CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Provide consumers with the knowledge to properly care for their product.  
Standards care instructions or generic symbols available. (United States requirement)

### 5 - PERMANENCE AND FORM

Label must be permanent, accessible, legible and must withstand at least 10 washes.



**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR GARMENT LABELLING.**

1. SIZING.
2. CARE INSTRUCTIONS IN CANADA
3. STYLE NAME OR NUMBER
4. COLOUR NAME OR NUMBER
