Printing on fleece garments is complex and certain restrictions apply to obtain a quality print. For a constant quality of printing it is preferable to limit the number of colours to

Two (2) colours that touch



Four (4) colours that do not touch



Why?

- The fleece can move on the table (thickness and brushing of the fabric) which makes it difficult to get an accurate print for multiple colour designs.
- The heat generated by the flashes (used in screen printing for multi-colour designs) can burn the garment or cause migration (the ink takes the colour of the garment).

In addition, it is best to avoid:

- Large designs and ink masses
- Small lettering and details of less than 1 mm
- The vintage effects of light colours on dark clothes because we cannot use anti-migration ink under a vintage logo



We do not screen print process on fleece.

A jersey garment is required for this type of print.

- · Printing on fleece requires that your logo be processed differently. Thus, if your order includes a batch of jersey clothing and another batch of fleece, additional fees may apply but the finished product will have more impact.
- · Screen printing on the hood is possible but limited to 1 colour and additional fees may apply for non-standard location.
