


Woven fabrics are used to make pants, shirts, bags and caps. Knit fabrics are used to make t-shirts and sweaters. At Attraction, we both manufacture and import knitwear. The two most common types of knitwear used in the market for the production of t-shirts or fleeces are:

Example 7 oz lightweight (GSM)

Ringspun cotton yarn is produced using ring frames and is made by continuously twisting and refining the strands to obtain a very fine yarn. The twisting process allows the short hair of the cotton to emerge, resulting in a strong and soft yarn. Fabric made from ringspun cotton is generally considered superior to cotton made from other processes, since the finished product is significantly finer, softer and more durable. Ringspun also provides a tight and smooth printing surface perfect for screen printing. For all these reasons, we only use ringspun knitwear at Attraction.

Example 10 oz Heavy (GSM)

The open-end spinning system is produced from short cotton fibers.

A rotor rotating at very high speed is fed with the short cotton fibers and the yarn is produced by continuously pulling an extended yarn through the rotor. This yarn, which is produced by the shorter cotton fibers, is rougher, but also very economical.



Our Ethica fabrics are made in Canada by Canadian companies using the best imported yarns* available specifically selected for their quality and their ecological footprint. In addition, most ethica fabrics are made in GOTS certified knitting factories and dyed in a GOTS certified factory using low impact dyes.

50% organic cotton / 50% recycled polyester jersey

100% organic cotton ringspun yarn fully combed, blended with post-consumer GRS certified recycled polyester.

100% organic cotton jersey

100% organic cotton ringspun yarn, GOTS certified, fully combed. In addition, ethica fabric is made in a GOTS certified knitting factory and dyed in a GOTS certified factory, using low-impact dyes.

50% organic cotton / 50% recycled polyester fleece

100% organic cotton ringspun yarn fully combed, blended with post-consumer recycled polyester certified GRS.
